We provide water refill stations in our properties and we are always looking to improve our processes to ensure they're sustainable.

THE ORCHARD HOTEL & RESTAURANT


Set in 330 acres of the University of Nottingham parkland, The Orchard Hotel has 202 bedrooms, 7 meeting rooms, a brasserie and is located next to the East Midlands Conference Centre.

The building uses a range of sustainable design features, incorporating natural materials alongside high-tech renewable energy systems to deliver efficiency in use and to create an outstanding space for guests.

The Orchard Hotel incorporates 50m² of solar PV into the building to provide on-site renewable energy. The building management system ensures that only occupied rooms use heating or cooling. The hotel has beaten its target for on-site CO₂ emissions and this is partly down to the fact that the team use remote metering to manage energy consumption.

Our guests can enjoy a peaceful walk in our green space, an outdoor meeting with colleagues, a gym session at David Ross or a delicious meal with friends and family at Bramleys Brasserie.











THE BRAILSFORD

This is a large event space that's used mostly for weddings, dinners, wakes, large conferences and training days. It's a flexible space that features bi-fold doors which open out onto a beautiful patio area.

It's close to the kitchen and to our hotel restaurant, making it perfect for buffets and sit down dinners. It can hold up to 100 guests in a theatre style or 40 guests as a boardroom set up.

THE SUITES

The Russet Suite is our smallest meeting room in The Orchard Hotel. It's perfect for small meetings or as a remote working space.


As with all our meeting rooms it's equipped with a large screen and click share. The room is usually set up in a boardroom format and can seat a maximum of 10 people.









BANQUETING SUITE


This is one of the largest spaces in the building with access to an outside courtyard. The natural daylight floods into this space, with floor-to-ceiling windows providing beautiful parkland views. This is a flexible space for exhibitions, awards dinners and seminars.

The Banqueting Suite can accommodate up to 1000 delegates in a theatre style layout.










CONFERENCE THEATRE

Our conference theatre was voted Best Auditorium (at the CHS Awards) for the second year in a row as well as being a finalist in the Best On-Site AV category.

This is a tiered seated auditorium for up to 520 delegates. The remote-retractable seating means the space can be easily adapted.
















CONFERENCE SUITES

Located on the lower ground floor our conference suites hold between 24-100 delegates and are perfect for training days, workshops and smaller informal meetings.

These suites are highly flexible and can be made larger or smaller using the bi-folding doors.


GALLERY SUITES

These are a series of intimate spaces located on the first floor. The Gallery Suites can cater for seminars, launch events and workshops. They can even double up as an office space when part of a larger event.

Seating 40-60 guests in a cabaret style arrangement, the room features privacy glass and is fully self-contained.









HUGH STEWART MANOR HOUSE

On the south west edge of Nottingham City centre, nestled in a woodland surrounding, stands Hugh Stewart House, a Grade II listed Gothic manor house with four elegant suites.

Completed in 1804, Hugh Stewart House was originally known as Lenton Hall from the early 19th Century until 1937.

A quick five minute drive away from The Orchard Hotel, these four grand rooms can be booked individually for a short break or for a group weekend getaway.

TO THE MANOR BORN

Stay in our Gothic Manor House and use the striking drawing room for private meetings and get-togethers.

This location is secluded with great access to the campus facilities as well as the city centre.


The building itself has been beautifully restored and combines a modern interpretation of traditional interior design.












EAST MEETS WEST

Home to 18 flexible and modern meeting rooms, our auditoriums can entertain up to 250 delegates in a theatre style. Both East and West Atriums have a tranquil waterside setting, home to many forms of wildlife.

Our West Atrium has eight small meeting rooms that can be booked for an event day with a buffet service in the breakout space. Our East Atrium is a similar set up with five meeting rooms and a breakout section in the middle.



CAMPUS VENUES CONFERENCES & ACCOMMODATION
